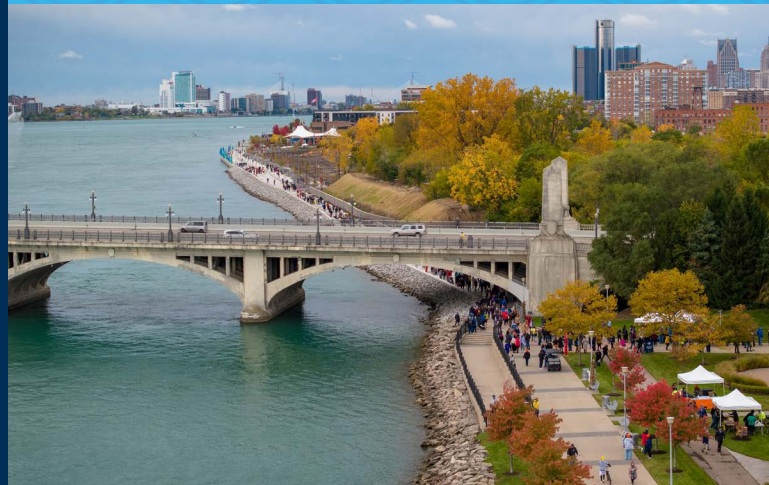

# RALPH C. WILSON, JR. CENTENNIAL PARK



## Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Centennial Park

1801 W. Jefferson Ave, Detroit, MI 48216



Opened on October 25, 2025, Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Centennial Park is a vibrant urban green space that celebrates the city's waterfront and rich cultural history. Spanning 22 acres along the Detroit River, this park offers stunning views, beautiful tree-lined walking trails, and multiple recreational areas for visitors to enjoy. Ralph Wilson Park will host multiple community programs in 2026 including fitness classes, nature-based education opportunities, family movie nights and more. Detroit Harvest Fest & Food Truck Rally will return to Ralph Wilson Park this October with dozens of food trucks, great local music and tons of activities for visitors of all ages.

### Delta Dental Play Garden

The Delta Dental Play Garden features epic slides and play structures, a splash-filled Water Wonderland, inclusive swings, treehouses and a tot lot, all designed to spark imagination and active play. Open daily until 9pm.

### William Davidson Sport House

The William Davidson Sport House is a striking open-air pavilion with two Detroit Pistons full-size basketball courts, serving as a year-round hub for recreation, connection and community gatherings. Open daily until 8pm.

### DTE Foundation Summit

The DTE Foundation Summit features sweeping river and skyline views, gentle hills and open green space designed for relaxation, recreation and taking in the beauty of the Detroit River.

### Huron-Clinton Metroparks Water Garden

The 2.5-acre Huron-Clinton Metroparks Water Garden, the first Metroparks location in the City of Detroit, offers winding paths, an open-air classroom and immersive environmental programming that connects visitors to water and nature.



## Cullen Plaza

1340 Atwater St, Detroit, MI 48207

Since opening in 2007, Cullen Plaza has become a popular destination for some of the most-visited attractions along the Detroit Riverfront, such as the Cullen Family Carousel, Bank of America Children’s Playscape, Diamond Jack Boat Tours and Wheelhouse Detroit Bicycle Shop.



## Robert C. Valade Park

2670 Atwater St, Detroit, MI 48207

Built on a former industrial site, Valade Park has transformed the riverfront since opening in 2019, linking Stroh River Place and the Aretha Franklin Amphitheatre. Families enjoy a sandy beach, musical gardens, local food and drinks, and year-round programming—from summer fun to cozy Winter at Valade with fireplaces, s’mores and themed weekends.

## Mt. Elliott Park

110 Mt. Elliott St, Detroit, MI 48207

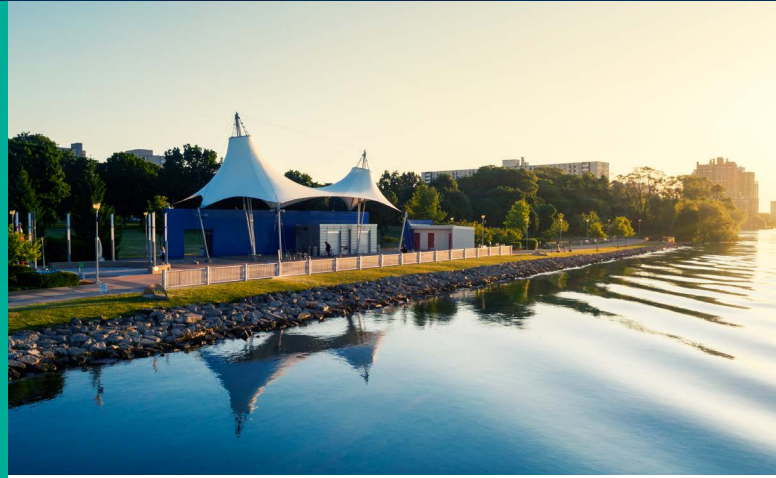
Opened in 2014, Mt. Elliott Park is home to the Gilbert Family Schooner, a Great Lakes-themed splash pad featuring cascading water, kid-activated cannons and interactive play elements, open Memorial Day to Labor Day (weather dependent). Universally accessible and thoughtfully designed, the park offers stunning views of the Detroit River and Belle Isle.

## Gabriel Richard Park

7130 E Jefferson Ave, Detroit, MI 48207

At the easternmost point of the Riverwalk, Gabriel Richard Park features lush gardens, a whimsical fountain, butterfly habitats, a contemplative labyrinth and fishing outlooks, plus a birding station with accessible scopes for wildlife viewing. The park connects to the East Riverwalk beneath the MacArthur Bridge, and links visitors to Belle Isle.

## Dequindre Cut

Located between Atwater St & Mack Ave in Eastern Market

Entrances at Atwater St, Franklin St, Woodbridge St, Lafayette St, Gratiot Ave, Wilkins St & Mack Ave



The Dequindre Cut Greenway is a nearly two-mile, below-grade pedestrian path connecting Eastern Market to the Detroit Riverfront. Featuring separate lanes for walking and biking, striking urban art and graffiti, and the lively Freight Yard with seasonal food, drinks and entertainment, it's a dynamic route for exploring the city.



## Southwest Greenway

Entrances at Bagley St & Jefferson Ave



The Southwest Greenway runs just over half a mile, connecting Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Centennial Park with the Michigan Central mobility innovation district, Corktown, Mexicantown and Southwest Detroit neighborhoods. The greenway also features The Yard Graffiti Museum, an outdoor gallery dedicated to the preservation of the graffiti and underground history of this space.

Kids and families can enjoy a small play area featuring a zip line with accessible seating and a large climbing log structure.

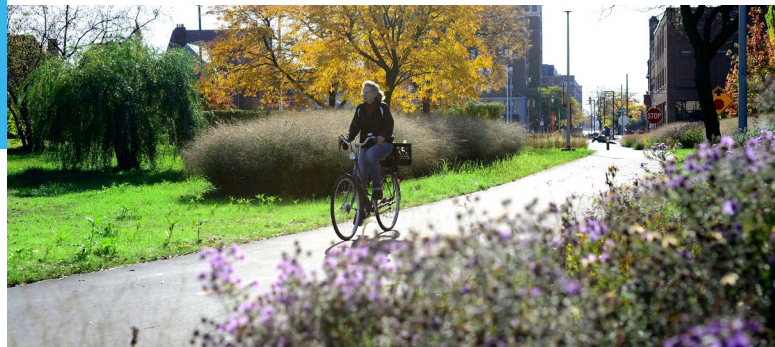

## Mayor Dennis W. Archer Greenway

Entrances at Jefferson Ave, Larned St, Lafayette St & Vernor Hwy

The Mayor Dennis W. Archer Greenway provides east side residents with safe and convenient access to the Detroit Riverfront along a beautifully-landscaped paved pathway.

The 1.2 mile path features a pedestrian plaza between Larned and Jefferson, benches, outdoor power stations, pickleball courts and playscapes.
